## Introduction

The idea of Cultivate Careers was born less than five months ago, we are so grateful to be in the position we find ourselves in now. Our sincerest thanks goes out to every donor that has made everything up to this point possible!

Last week, over \$700 worth of educational tools were sent to three villages in El Salvador (El Junquillo, La Hacienda, and El Colón) as a gift to the elementary school students. Thanks to all the donations we received, we were able to purchase much needed equipment that will stimulate thinking and advance learning for current and future students in El Salvador.

Cultivate Careers would also like to thank our partner for this campaign, FUNDAHMER. FUNDAHMER is a nonprofit social organization based in El Salvador and approved by the Salvadoran government. This organization accompanies the poor in the struggle for justice by supporting community initiatives to transform the conditions of poverty, exclusion, and marginalization of populations in the zones of Morazan, La Libertad, Colon, and San Salvador. FUNDAHMER acted as our gateway to the three villages, as they work directly with them. Through constant communication, our organizations worked together to follow through with the process of sending and delivering the educational tools.

FUNDAHMER provided a list of what specific donations would be most beneficial for their students' curriculum. Confirming that the items were in line with Cultivate Careers' mission, we utilized donations that were allocated starting on February 7, 2023 and ending on May 19, 2023 to purchase a total of sixty-nine separate educational tools of all shapes and sizes.


Finally, we are grateful for the annual Brophy immersion trip that agreed to deliver the educational tools to each village.



Education for Children in El Salvador




Education is free in El Salvador up until the 9th grade, yet 18% of students drop out before then.




only 33% of students eligible for secondary school actually attend.


## Children and Poverty in El Salvador



½ of the population's children and teenagers survive off less than \$1.25 a day.

Roughly 10% of school-aged children work as child laborers.





Approximately 1 in 3 children can't afford secondary school. Instead, they work to help their family survive.

Inadequate education leads to a lack of opportunities within the country, cementing these children in the cycle of poverty.
